


# Rothwell Primary Schools Parents Guide to Accessing Classroom Assignments - Laptop/Desktop Mode




Once pupils have logged into Google Classroom, they will see the stage/year overview page. From here they can see the stage/year they are registered to - clicking on their stage/year group will open that classroom.




Stream shows a list of posts made to the class by teachers. This includes announcements, questions and any homework or assignments.

Classwork is the area where all work, or 'Assignments', will be found. In here, you will also find key documents to support learning as well as learning from previous days. Click to enter.




There will be a suggested timetable for the day. Open this by clicking on it. There might also be other useful resources to support your learning.




We aim to always have the day's work at the top of the page. Click on the learning for the day and it will open up the assignment.



A list of key sections within the Classwork part of Google Classroom can be found here, **including work set on previous days.**




Click on 'View Assignment' and you will be able to access your learning for that subject for the day.

There is a section here for class comments. You might want to write a short message to the class or your teacher might write something that they want everyone to see. **Remember all that has been taught about staying safe online.**





Private comments can be used if you need some help or maybe the work is too difficult. Only your teacher can see these.

All teachers have tried to ensure that these are editable - this means that children can type their answers into the documents; these will automatically save their work.




There is also the opportunity to create your own slides or documents. This is great if you have a photograph of your work that you would like to share.



Once you completed **ALL** of your work, click on **Hand in**.




# Using Google Slides




If you hover the answer box it will bring a blue box up. When the box is present you can type your answer in there. You can make the box bigger if required
